Award Description and Criteria

The Gregory A. Hendel Lifetime Service Award (The Hendel Award) honors those who have significantly nurtured life, youth development, and growth in the community through lifelong support of Scouting and leadership positions in the business community. Honorees are individuals who, as adults, have performed outstanding service of a sustained, direct and consequential nature.

To be eligible for the Hendel Award, an individual's service must:

- extend beyond Scouting to the community at large, specifically including leadership roles in the business community;
- be significant in nature and produce measurable results;
- reflect favorably on Scouting America and Erie Shores Council; and,
- be of a sustained nature and directly impact the lives of those who live within Erie Shores Council.

While there is no specific time threshold to qualify, the Erie Shores Council Gregory A. Hendel Lifetime Service Award is intended to recognize exceptional service over an extended period of time and not a single act or achievement.
