FAQ AND WEBSITE LINKS:

- Door hanger (tag) distribution and donation pickup should occur in your designated area.
- Travel in groups of two or more Scouts with adequate adult supervision (Two Deep Leadership), do not enter homes.
- Wear your Field Uniforms for both door hanger (tag) distribution and donation pick up.
- Do not place door hangers (tags) in or attach them to U.S. mailboxes. Hang door hangers (tags) on the door. Distribute door hangers (tags) to private residences only, avoid businesses and apartment complexes.
- Remember to pick up donations promptly, within your designated area.
- Contact food pantries beforehand to ensure timely delivery, and take plenty of pictures of Scouts in action for use on social media.
- Once donations are collected, don't forget to enter your service hours at: <http://advancements.scouting.org/> (include the number of items collected), so you can earn free patches. *See tips below on entering service hours.*

ENTERING SERVICE HOURS:

By following these tips, your unit has a higher chance of successfully entering all hours correctly and receiving your patch (recognition) quickly.

1. Be sure to make separate entries for both the Pack and Troop, as well as separate entries for both tag distribution and donation collection.
2. Log onto Scoutbook Plus from <https://advancements.scouting.org>
3. At the menu on the left side of the screen, click on “**Activity Logs.**”
4. Select each unit member who participated in the activity.
5. Click “**Record Progress**” from the action bar and then choose “**Service Hours.**”
6. Use the calendar to select the activity **start** date.
7. Click “**Create New Activity.**”
8. Enter the activity details (Activity Name, Start & End Dates, Location, Hours).
9. Click “**Record And Finish**”
