Award Description and Criteria

The Glenda M. Bowman Lifetime Service Award (The Bowman Award) was established in 2012 to honor Glenda M. Bowman, who served her community through exemplary lifelong service. The Bowman Award is intended to honor lifelong inspirational leadership, examples of which would include: serving as a positive role model and mentor; demonstrating courage in the face of adversity; fostering the spirit and intent of diversity; and, motivating and helping others to reach their full potential.

To be eligible for the Bowman Award, an individual's service must:

- be significant in nature;
- reflect favorably on Scouting America and Erie Shores Council; and,
- be of a sustained nature and directly impact the lives of those who live within Erie Shores Council.

While there is no specific time threshold to qualify, the Erie Shores Council Glenda M. Bowman Award for Inspirational Leadership is intended to recognize exceptional service over an extended period of time and not a single act or achievement.
