The following is a checklist of equipment that you **must** bring to the Ordeal:

### **YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE WITHOUT IT!!**

- ☐ Copy of current Scout Physical (Parts A & B)
- ☐ If you must carry medication with you, please have it in the original container.
- ☐ Complete BSA uniform for your program
- ☐ Ground cloth/tarp – Should be large enough for you to lay on and cover yourself up.
- ☐ Sleeping Bag – Check the weather; Sleeping bag should be rated for night temperature.
- ☐ Rain gear – We WILL be outside in whatever conditions we encounter.
- ☐ Canteen/Water bottle – A hydrated camper is a happy camper.
- ☐ Work clothes and gloves – Durable and able to get dirty.
- ☐ Other outer wear items to keep warm.
- ☐ Tent – This will be for Saturday night, **not Friday**. Tent sharing is permitted on Saturday **if YPT compliant**.
- ☐ Spending money, if desired, for OA items on sale after the Ordeal.

Check-in will be from 7:00 PM until 9:00 PM on Friday evening, at the OA Cabin (Epworth). The weekend will wrap up around 11:00 AM Sunday morning.
